## **Installation Procedures**

# NOTE: THE ADAPTOR MUST BE REMOVED.



Effective December 2008: A103-160S elements are replacing A103-160 Elements. Old A103-160 Elements can be used with manual drain Coalescent Filter models. Coalescent Filter models with auto drain or new float drain MUST use new A103-160S.

The A103-160S/L Element Kits replace the A103-133 Kits. Before installing the A103-160S/L Element Assembly for the FIRST time, the Adaptor must be removed. Coalescent Filters purchased AFTER October 2006 do NOT include the Adaptor, so Step 4 can be skipped.

### INSTALLATION:

- 1. Depressurize and lockout air pressure.
- 2. Remove Bowl Ring and Bowl Assembly by turning counter-clockwise.
- 3. Remove OLD Coalescent Element Assembly by turning counter-clockwise.
- 4. Remove Adaptor by turning counter-clockwise using needle nose pliers. (See picture below.)
- 5. The NEW Coalescent Element Assembly can now be installed into Head by turning clockwise. (See picture below.)
